There are four and a half barrels of the 2016 Corton-Bressandes Grand Cru this year. I love the bouquet here, pure and delineated, a mixture of red and black fruit, perhaps more of the latter compared to the Corton-Perrières. The palate is very well balanced with fine tannin, tensile in the mouth with a precise and edgy finish that is a real treat. This is a great little Corton from Frédéric, and it should give 10 to 12 years of drinking pleasure.
